- actions happening now, in this moment.
- an action that is unfinished, that is going on during this period.
- action or event in the future.

It's raining.

→ Está lloviendo.

We are using the internet.

→ Nosotros estamos usando el internet.

They are playing football after school.

→ Ellos están jugando futbol después del colegio.

She is talking with her friends.

→ Ella está hablando con sus amigas.

The boys are sleeping in the tent.

→ Los niños duermen en la tienda de campaña.

What are they doing?

→ ¿Qué están haciendo?

They are listening to me.

→ Ellos me están escuchando.

What are you going to do in the afternoon?

→ ¿Qué vas a hacer en la tarde?
