

Guion de la dramatización:

José Luis Turcios / 5to Bach.

"The Great Museum Heist".

**Characters:**

**Laura:** the museum director.

**Pedro:** the security guard.

**Ana:** the art expert hired for the exhibition.

**Carlos:** the skilled and cunning thief.

**Scene 1: Preparing for the exhibition:**

(Laura, Pedro, and Ana are in the museum, discussing the final details for the art exhibition that will take place that night.)

Laura: "Everything is looking beautiful! Thank you for your hard work, Ana! Pedro, make sure all the security systems are in place."

Pedro: "Yes, ma'am. Everything is ready. We have guards patrolling the area and security cameras in every exhibition room."

Ana: "I'm so excited for tonight. I think we'll have a lot of visitors interested in the exhibition."

Laura: "I hope so. We need everything to go smoothly so that sponsors keep supporting the museum. All we can do now is wait."

**Scene 2: The robbery**

(When night has fallen, a man enters the museum stealthily. It is Carlos, the thief. With his skill and cunning, he manages to evade the security guards and heads towards the main exhibition room. There, he begins taking the most valuable pieces of art and hiding them in a backpack.)

Carlos: (whispering) "Alright, Carlos, you have to be quick and cunning. You only have a few minutes before someone discovers you."

(Pedro, the security guard, patrols the main exhibition room and realizes something strange is happening.)

Pedro: "What's that noise? I need to investigate."

(As he turns the corner, he runs into Carlos.)

Pedro: "Hey, you! Stop!"

(Carlos pulls out a gun and points it at Pedro.)

Carlos: "Don't try to stop me. This is just a job."

(Laura and Ana hear the commotion and run towards the main exhibition room. There, they find Pedro and Carlos in a confrontation.)

Laura: "Oh my God! What's happening here?"

Ana: "It's the thief! The one who wanted to steal the artworks!"

(Carlos tries to escape, but the guards chase him and manage to catch him. Laura, Pedro, and Ana breathe a sigh of relief as they see that all the artworks have been recovered.)

Laura: "Thank God everything turned out alright. I'm so grateful to you guys. I could never have imagined such an ending to this night."

Pedro: "We just did our job, ma'am!"

Ana: "Yes, but it was also a great team effort. I'm glad to have been a part of it."

(The scene ends with the characters smiling and hugging each other.)
